Position Summary:

The Turf Grass Maintenance Intern plays an important role in our daily maintenance operations. This position focuses on individual goals and will help you grow as a professional turf grass manager.

Essential Job Functions:

- Course setup and Maintenance
- Calibration and application of liquid and dry materials
- Irrigation repair and maintenance.
- Assisting with project management.
- All types of mowing and grounds care.
- Assist in staff training and supervision.

Other Responsibilities:

- Cart path repair and maintenance.
- Drainage improvements and additions.
- Landscape projects to improve aesthetics and safety.

ADA Requirements

- Continuously
 - Walking
 - Standing
 - Repetitive use of hands and arms.
 - Lifting up to 25 pounds
 - Visual acuity to determine accuracy, neatness and thoroughness of work assigned, and determine safety of workplace surroundings for themselves and guests.
- Frequently
 - Balancing
 - Crouching
 - Grasping
 - Pulling or Pushing
 - Talking
 - Hearing
 - Lifting up to 50 pounds

- Occasionally
 - Lifting more than 100 pounds occasionally
- Environmental Conditions
 - Continuously working in outside conditions. This includes extreme heat continuously, humidity frequently, and occasion cold weather.
 - The worker is subject to vibrations frequently.
 - Frequently exposed to chemicals.
 - Frequently exposed to fumes, odors, and dust.

- Be able to exercise communication skills that will inform and serve guests.

- Able to work well in a team.
